
Call for Papers

All undergraduates, graduate students, alumni, and faculty from Utah institutions of higher learning are encouraged to submit papers and book reviews of historical significance to the journal for publication. We cover a wide array of topics of human interest, including social, political, economic and technological issues. Historical context for the purpose of this journal is very inclusive; therefore, we encourage submissions from students in outside disciplines, especially those submissions which help explain historical events or human phenomena.

Published articles will be available to the public both online at epubs.utah.edu and through a 250-page US trade paperback version. As a recognized academic journal, students published in Utah Historical Review will find their work indexed by Academia.edu, Google Scholar and other catalogs of scholarly work.

The Journal will have the following sections:

- Undergraduate Papers
 - Underclassmen: Papers from freshmen and sophomores.
 - Upperclassmen: Papers from juniors, seniors and those who have just completed their degrees.
- Graduate Papers: Both Masters and PhD students are represented.
- History Professionals: Faculty and those who work in history professions are invited to submit work.
- Book Reviews: Reviews of books published within the last 24 months which deal with historical topics.



The *Utah Historical Review* seeks to encourage and promote history scholarship on all academic levels; therefore, we seek to publish quality papers from graduate students, upper-classmen, and lower-classmen. UHR evaluates papers by taking into account the level of academic experience the student-writer has attained. During the last three years, UHR has published papers by students from Brigham Young University, Salt Lake Community College, University of Utah, Utah State University, Utah Valley University, and Weber State.

UHR will be hosting a workshop for students from all Utah colleges and universities who are interested in participating in this year's journal – either as authors or editors. Attendance is not mandatory for participation; however, it will be very helpful. The workshop will be held on November 8th, 2013 at 12 PM in room 101 of the Carolyn Tanner Irish Humanities Building at the University of Utah.



The *Utah Historical Review* is the yearly history journal published by Phi Alpha Theta – Alpha Rho, the University of Utah's chapter of the National History Honor Society. Students of history of all levels, from high school to graduate school are invited to submit articles to the journal. The Utah Historical Review is published annually in June since 2011 in both print and electronic formats.
